When she arrived for her in-take (without a parent, as usual) she was dressed in her work uniform and explained that her priorities had changed. She was no longer using weed and alcohol and was committed to holding down a job and catching up in school. She did exactly that and was able to return to STHS as an early grad this year. Last summer she was a Generation Green employee by day and held a restaurant job at night. I frequently saw her riding her bike between jobs at all hours. I would love to see the tenacity and motivation of this student be rewarded.
